## Coronavirus update

The European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC) with regards to coronavirus has assessed the risk within the EU/EEA and UK population in Europe as low. The UK National Health Service advises that while the public risk has been raised to moderate, the risk to individuals remains low. However, we request our attendees to remain vigilant to prevent the further spread of the disease.

The health and safety of our guests, speakers, colleagues, sponsors and local partners at EuroFinance are of utmost importance. We are continuing to monitor the spread of the Novel Coronavirus and are following the advice of local government and public health officials including the CDC and WHO.

If you are travelling for this event, we ask that all attendees who have travelled to China in the last month ensure that at least 14 days have passed from the time they arrived from China to the event, and that they have shown no flu-like symptoms during this time. If you have, we ask that for your own safety and the safety of other attendees, that you send another attendee in your place and refrain from attending the event.

Please note if you have returned from the following areas since February 19 you should get in contact with your health practitioner, stay indoors and avoid contact with people even if you don't have symptoms.

- · China Hubei Province
- · Iran
- Northern Italy designated areas delimitated by the government of Italy
- South Korea designated areas delimitated by the government of the Republic of Korea
- · Vietnam
- Cambodia
- · Laos
- Myanmar

If you have not travelled to these areas but are unwell or feeling flu-like symptoms, even if these are mild we recommend you stay at home and send someone on your behalf to attend the event.

As precautionary measures, we will increase the number of hands sanitiser dispensers and will be requesting our attendees to use it on arrival. Please note your body temperature might be assessed on arrival using a non-body temperature device.
